MBINGA – MBAMBA BAY ROAD (67 km) TO BITUMEN STANDARD

1. The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania has received loan from the African Development Bank (AfDB) to finance Transport Sector Support Program (TSSP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds of the loans for eligible payments for consulting services for Technical Audit for Upgrading of Tabora-Koga-Mpanda Road (342.9 km) and Mbinga – Mbamba Bay Road (67km) to Bitumen Standard.
2. The services included under this project are:
 - a) Assess, evaluate and provide a factual report on the effectiveness of the processes and procedures in use during project implementation;
 - b) Perform a diagnosis of the set of procedures and mechanisms used by the Contractor and Construction Supervision Consultant (CSC) in their respective duties of implementation and supervision;
 - c) Verify whether works performed by the Contractor and CSC meets the criteria of quality, economy and efficiency; and
 - d) Identify implementation constraints or shortcomings and propose recommendations to improve existing arrangements.

The duration of the assignment is 48 months.

3. The Tanzania National Roads Agency (TANROADS) an Executive Agency of the Ministry of Works, Transport and Communication now invites eligible Consultants to express their interest in providing the above mentioned services. Interested Consultants must provide information indicating their qualifications for performing the services. Such information may include brochures, description of assignments of similar nature in the last 10 years, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate managerial and technical skills among staff related to the assignment, etc. For each completed project, the Consultant shall provide the name and address of the Client, start and completed dates, name(s) of lead and associate firms. Cited projects with insufficient information will not be considered. Consultants may form joint-ventures to enhance their chances of qualification.
4. Eligibility criteria, establishment of the short-list and selection procedure shall be in accordance with the African Development Bank's: "Rules and Procedures for the Use of Consultants May 2008 Edition-Revised July 2012" which is available on the Banks's website at <http://www.afdb.org>.
