CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR SUPERVISION OF CONSTRUCTION OF KIGONGO/BUSISI BRIDGE (3.2 KM) AND ITS APPROACH ROADS (1.66 KM); TENDER NO. AE/001/2018 - 19 /HQ/C/64

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST (INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIVE SELECTION)

1. The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania has allocated funds in the Financial Year 2018/19 towards the cost of carrying out a Consultancy Services for Supervision of Construction of the Kigongo/Busisi Bridge (3.2 Km) and its approach roads (1.66 Km) along Usagara – Geita –Buzirayombo – Kyamyorwa road at the vicinity of Kigongo/Busisi ferry crossing. The project site is located in Mwanza Region.

The design of Kigongo/Busisi Bridge is made of combination of approach bridges and a main bridge that is extra-dosed. The main bridge is 520 m long with two main spans of 160m to allow two navigational waterway routes. The approach bridges on both Kigongo and Busisi are 1,240m long each; split into 31 spans of 40m length each made of pre-stressed concrete beam girders.

2. The scope of the assignment includes but not limited to:
 - i. Carry out design review of Kigongo/Busisi Bridge and its approach roads.
 - ii. Supervision of the Works Contract to ensure that construction activities comply with approved Design, Drawings, Specifications, Conditions of Contract and sound engineering practice.
 - iii. Supervision of maintenance activities during the Defects Liability Period.

The estimated period of the assignment is 84 months involving 48 months of Construction Supervision and 36 months of Defects Liability Period.

3. The Tanzania National Roads Agency (TANROADS), an Executive Agency of the Ministry of Works, Transport and Communication now invites eligible Consultants to express interest in providing the above mentioned services. Interested Consultants must provide information indicating their qualifications for performing the services. Such information may include brochures, description of assignments of similar nature in the last 10 years, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate managerial and technical skills among staff related to the assignment, etc. For each completed project, the Consultant shall provide the name and address of the Client, start and completed dates, name(s) of lead and associate firms. Cited projects with insufficient information shall not be considered.
4. Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications. Foreign firms must associate with local firms to become eligible for the assignment. The associations must be in the form of Sub-Consultancy or Joint Venture only. Consultants must demonstrate capacity for execution of the project under Expressions of interest. In case of associations, capacities of associated partners will be joined and examined.
5. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with policies and procedures laid down in the Public Procurement (Amendment) Act, 2016 and Public Procurement (Amendment) Regulations, 2016.
