**UPGRADING OF DUMILA - KILOSA – ULAYA - MIKUMI ROAD (142 KM) TO BITUMEN STANDARD, LOT 2:
RUDEWA - KILOSA SECTION (24 KM)**

1. The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania has set aside funds for the operation of the Tanzania National Roads Agency (TANROADS) during the FY 2016/17. It is intended that part of the proceeds of the funds will be used to cover eligible payments under the contract for the **Upgrading of Dumila-Kilosa-Ulaya-Mikumi Road (142 Km) to Bitumen Standard, Lot 2: Rudewa - Kilosa Section (24 Km), Tender No. AE/001/2016-17/HQ/W/15.**
2. The Tanzania National Roads Agency (TANROADS) an Agency of the Ministry of Works, Transport and Communication hereinafter referred to as the Employer now invites sealed tenders from eligible and qualified Contractors for carrying out the **Upgrading of Dumila-Kilosa-Ulaya-Mikumi Road (142 Km) to Bitumen Standard, Lot 2: Rudewa - Kilosa Section (24 Km), Tender No. AE/001/2016-17/HQ/W/15.**
3. Tendering will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding procedures specified in the Public Procurement Regulations, 2013 – Government Notice No. 446 and is open to National Tenderers only as defined in the Regulations.
4. The Project is earmarked for local Contractors capacity building. The local Contractors of any Class are required to form a Joint Venture of at least three Contractors whose combined capacities will qualify for registration as Class I Contractor.
5. The works consist of the upgrading of the existing gravel road to Bitumen standard, construction of embankment, drainage structures involving bridges, box culverts, pipe culverts as well as pavement layers and ancillary works. The estimated quantities for major items of works are as follows:

6. Tenderers should note that to qualify for award of the contract, they are required to meet certain minimum qualifying criteria. It should be noted that tenderers must be able to demonstrate that, in the capacity as a prime Contractor, they should have successfully completed at least **one (1) project** of similar nature of at least **5 km** bitumen standard road within the last ten (10) years. Tenderers are required to provide full and detailed particulars of their financial capability to perform such works and to demonstrate that they have experienced key personnel with appropriate qualifications. As part of proof of experience on road project, Tenderers are required to submit certified form of Contract for awarded Contract in the past, Taking Over and Completion Certificates duly certified together with Telephone Number and e-mail addresses of the previous Employer/Awarding Agency. Tenderers should also note that the works must be completed within **Eighteen (18) months inclusive of three (3) months** of mobilization period and that they are required to provide detailed particulars of all items of equipment and plant that they deem necessary to deploy for the timely completion of the works. **Tenderers who are proven non-performers should not apply as they will be disqualified.**
7. A complete set of Tendering Document(s) in English language and additional sets may be purchased by interested Tenderers on the submission of a written application to the address given under paragraph 7 above and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **TShs 300,000 (Tanzania Shillings Three Hundred Thousand Only)**. Tenderers can collect the Tendering Documents between 08:00 to 04:30 pm from Monday to Friday inclusive, except on public holidays at the Employer's head office in Dar es Salaam, Document will not be dispatched by courier service.

9. Tender shall be valid for a period of **120 days** after Tender opening, and must be accompanied by a "Tender Security" in original and in an acceptable form in the amount of **TShs. 50,000,000 (Tanzania Shillings Fifty Million only)** or its equivalent in a freely convertible currency, and the tender must be submitted or be sent by a registered post to: **The Secretary, TANROADS Headquarters Tender Board, 4th Floor, Airtel House, Ali Hassan Mwinyi/Kawawa Roads junction, P.O. Box 11364 Dar es Salaam, TANZANIA** so as to reach him on or before the deadline for submission of tenders.

The Tender Security shall be clearly addressed to: **The Chief Executive, TANROADS, P. O. Box 11364, Dar es Salaam**. The Tender Security shall be valid for **Twenty eight days (28)** beyond the end of the validity of the tender.

10. The deadline for submission of Tenders shall be at **10:00 Hours local time on 24th May 2017**.

Tenders will be opened in public in **TANROADS Conference Room, 4th Floor, TANROADS Headquarters, Airtel House, Ali Hassan Mwinyi/Kawawa Roads Junction, Dar es Salaam**, immediately after submission deadline and in the presence of Tenderers' representatives who choose to attend. The outer cover of the Tenders must be clearly marked **"Upgrading of Dumila – Kilosa – Ulaya - Mikumi Road (142 Km) to Bitumen Standard, Lot 2: Rudewa - Kilosa Section (24 Km), Tender No. AE/001/2016-17/HQ/W/15**.

12. Late tenders, portion of tenders, electronic tenders, tenders not received, tenders not opened and not read out in public at the tender opening ceremony shall not be accepted for evaluation irrespective of the circumstance.
