The road corridor starts from Dar es Salaam city and ends at Kigoma region at the Lake Tanganyika. The road corridor from Dar es Salaam to Dodoma (451 Km) and Uvinza to Kigoma (112 Km) are paved. The intermediate part of the road corridor from Dodoma to Uvinza is unpaved.

 - i) Design Review and Supervision of Works to ensure that they comply with the approved design, drawings, specifications, Conditions of Contract and sound engineering practice;
